

Community Concerns Survey 2007

Released for Publication April 18, 2008

The perception that alcohol, tobacco and other illegal drugs are a problem in our community is widely acknowledged and heavily covered in the media. Yet, to know the extent of the problem is often hard to pin down without thorough data collection methods. Being that this self-reported data is hard and infrequent to come by, perceptions of community members is often a way to get to part of this issue. Region 6 Behavioral Healthcare took on this task by putting together a community concerns survey including rating concern levels for alcohol, tobacco, illegal drug, social experience, and school experience issues to assess greatest concern. The survey also included questions regarding ease of alcohol access by youth from family, friends, and adult strangers; along with questions regarding readiness for change on several areas of alcohol use. The survey was administered through a convenience sample, with 381 final respondents. These results will be disseminated to the community at large, community stakeholders and community coalitions that are working to prevent the use and abuse of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.

Among the results of this survey, drinking and driving was found to be the highest alcohol concern in almost every sub-group; claiming at least 40% or more of the respondents' highest concern. Overall, drinking and driving accounted for 58.9% of all respondents' most concerning issue regarding alcohol. Methamphetamine accounted for 66.8% of all respondents' highest concern in of illegal drugs, and health factors were highest concern in the Tobacco category at 50.0%.

Regarding the community's readiness to make a change on binge drinking, underage drinking and drinking and driving; more than 80% of respondents reported that their community was somewhat ready, ready or very ready; even higher percentages were found in some sub-groups for underage drinking and drinking and driving.

A final and promising result was from the question "how likely are you to actively participate in a change in alcohol issues in your community?"; 90.5% of respondents stated that they were very likely, likely, or somewhat likely to participate in a change. With this number of respondents willing to take a chance, we could see a positive change in these areas of concern in the future.

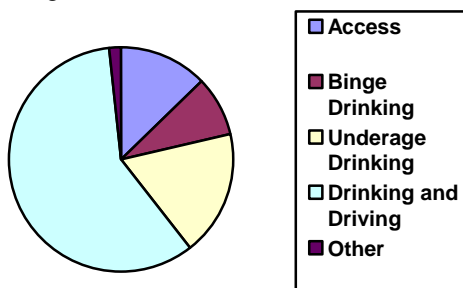

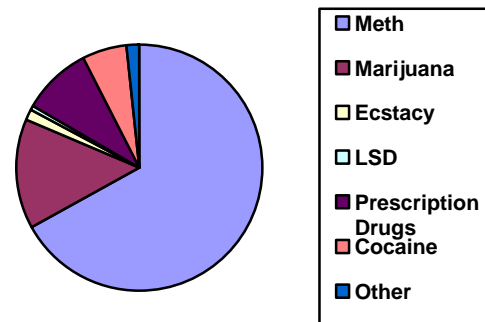

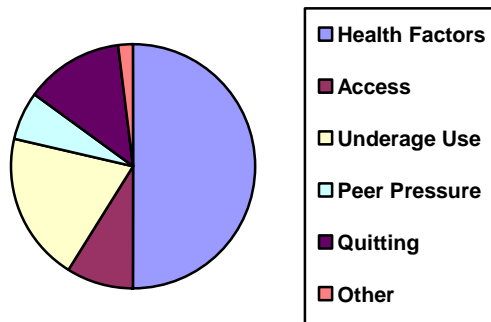

Chart 3: Highest Tobacco Concern



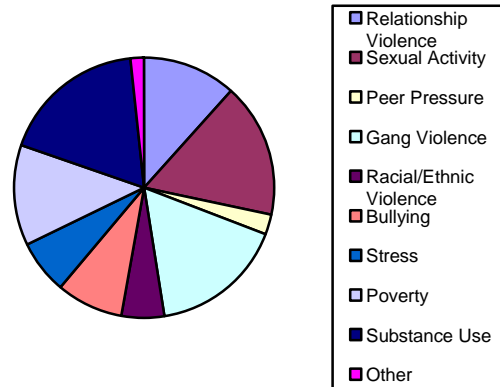

Chart 4: Highest Social Experience Concern



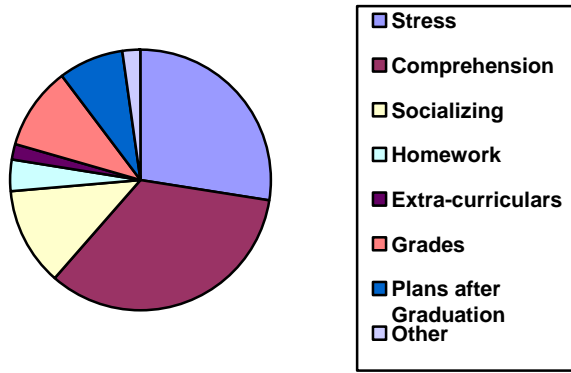

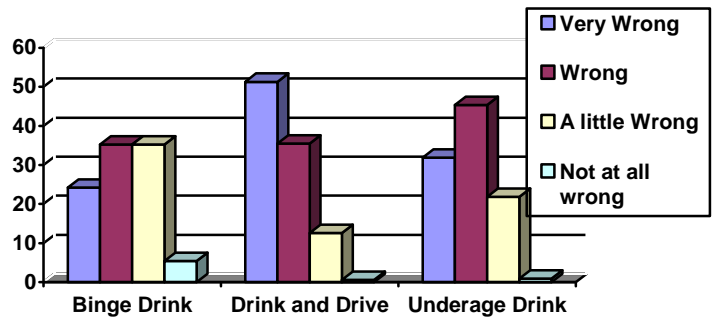

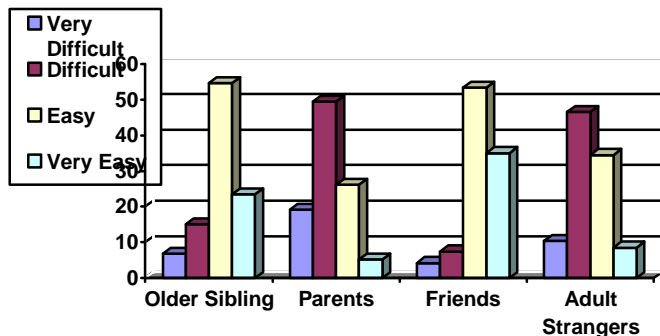

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



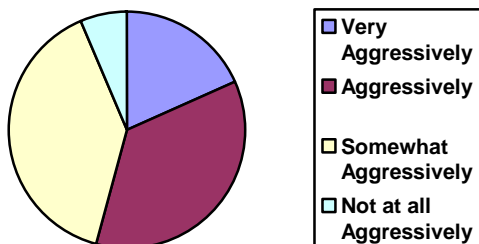

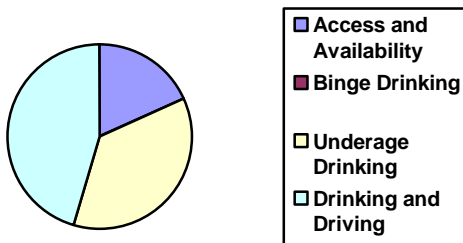

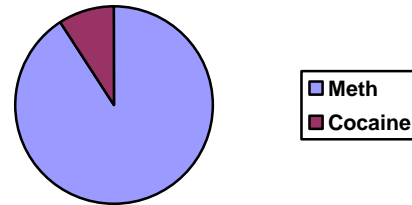

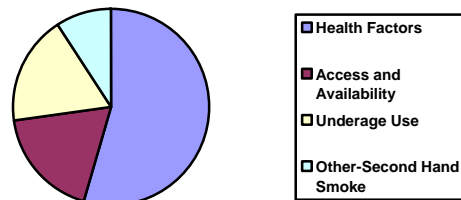

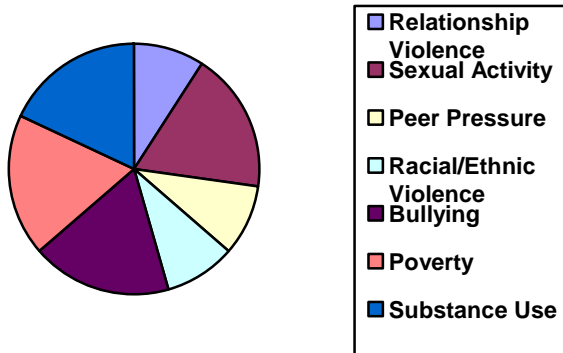

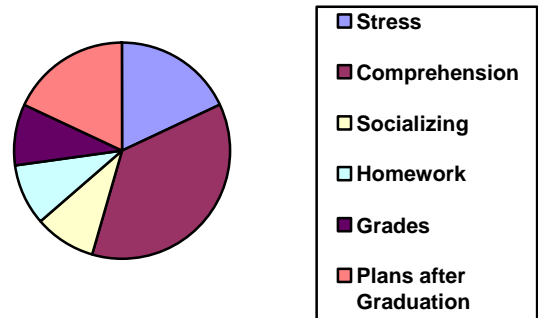
Chart 4: Highest Social Experience Concern

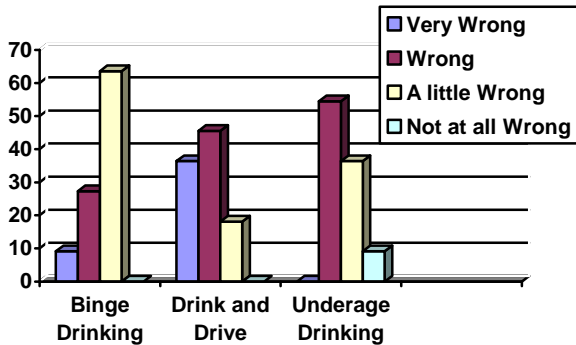

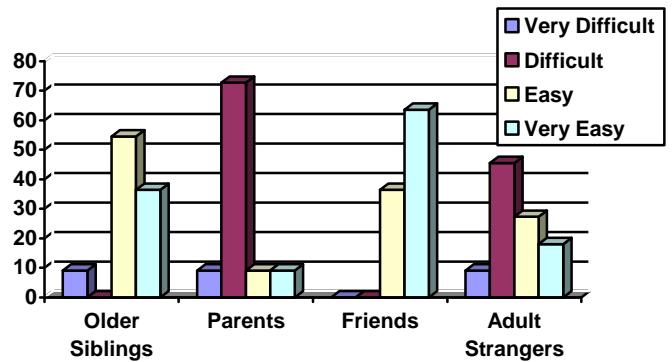

Chart 7: How difficult is it for youth to get alcohol from...



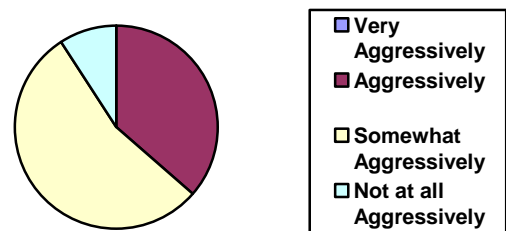

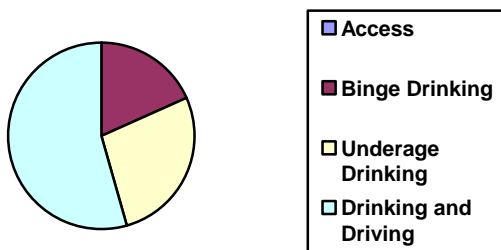

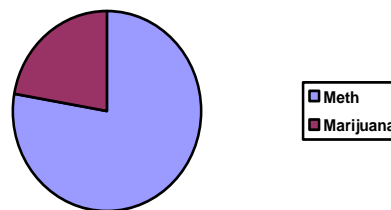

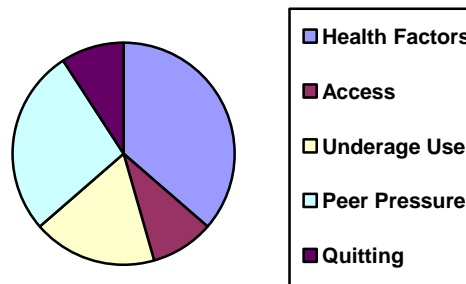

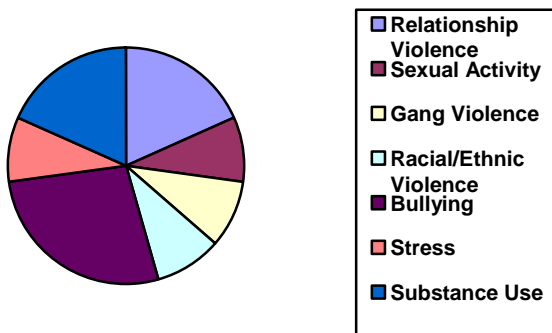

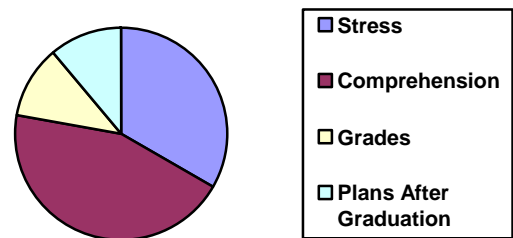

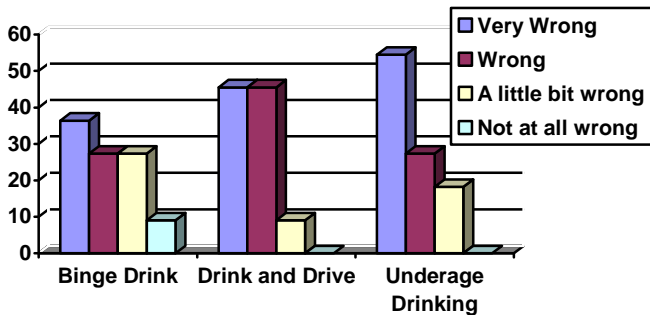

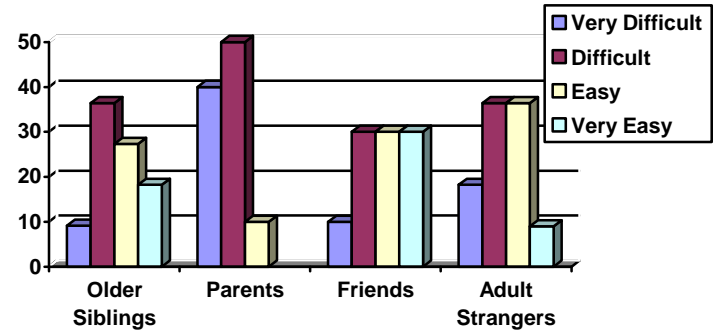

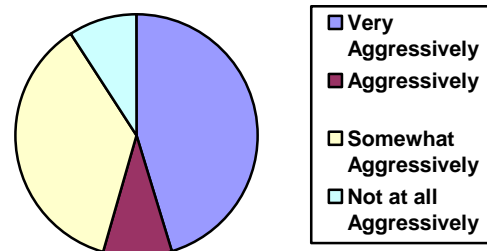

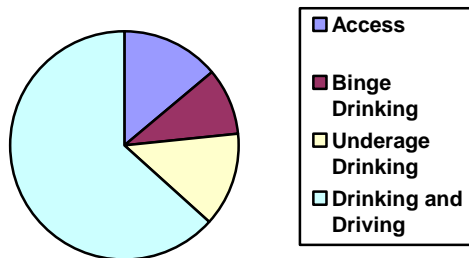

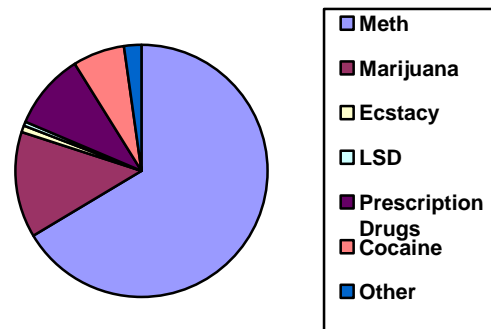

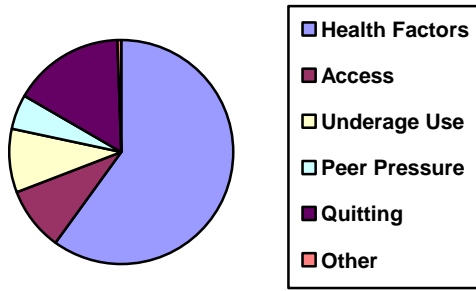

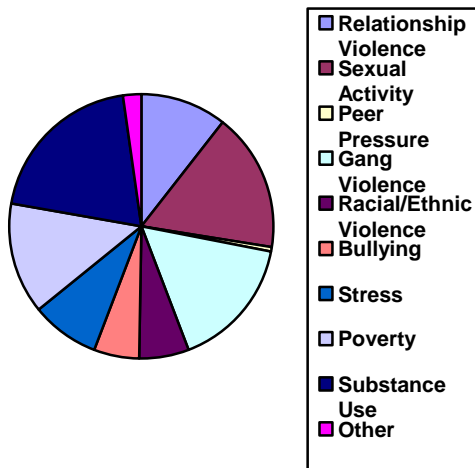

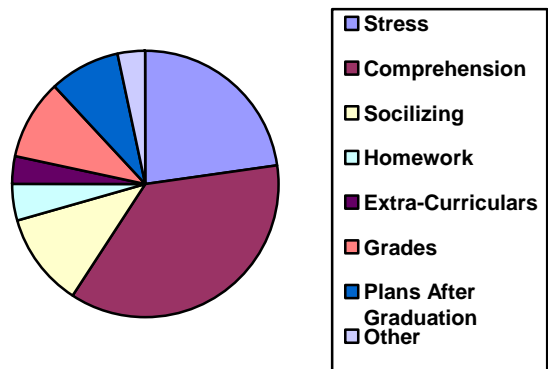

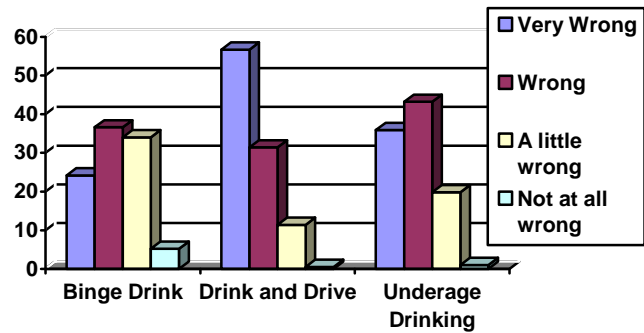

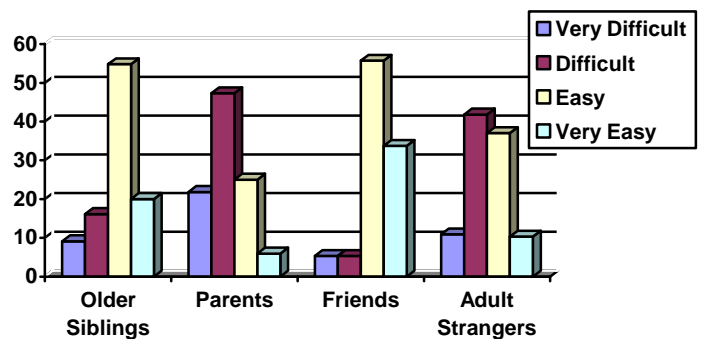

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



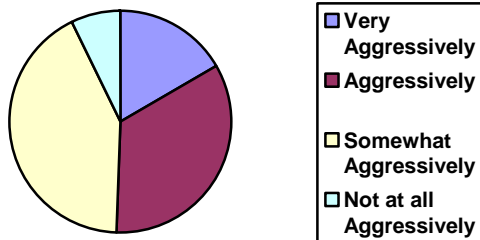

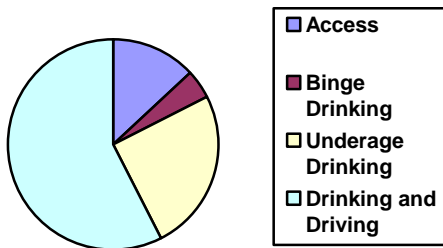

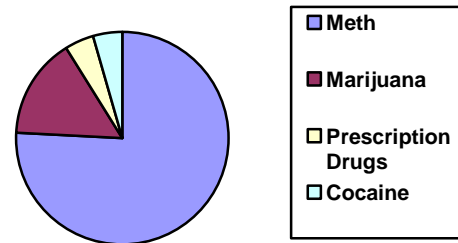

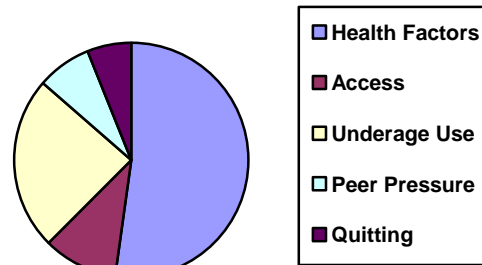

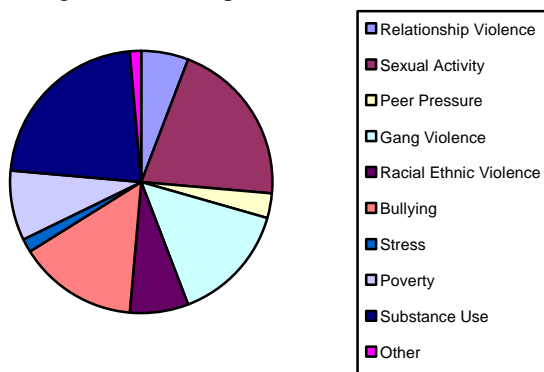

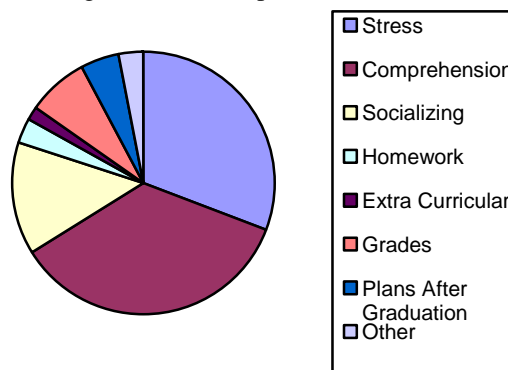

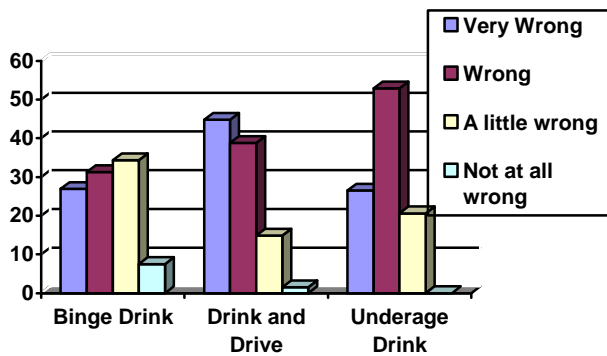

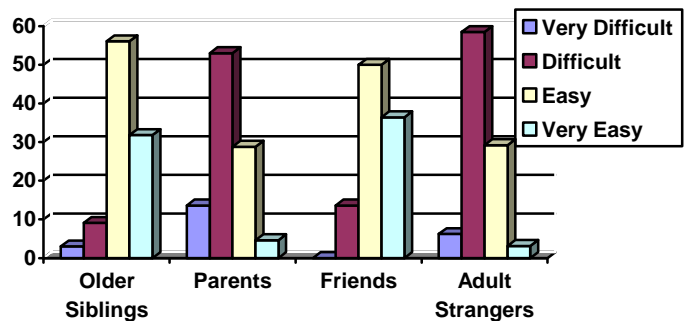

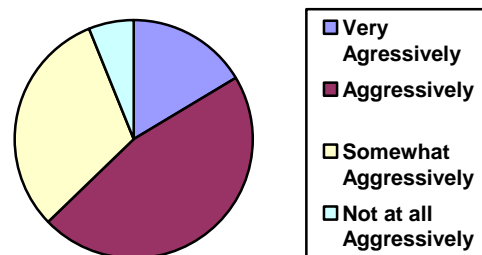

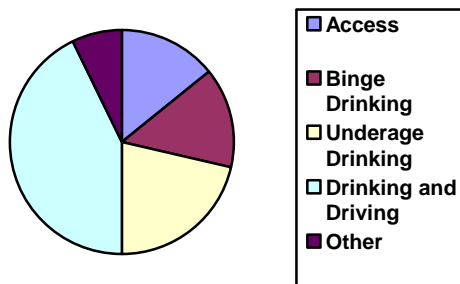

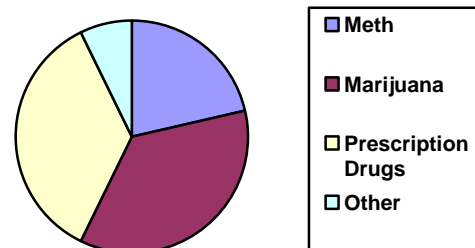

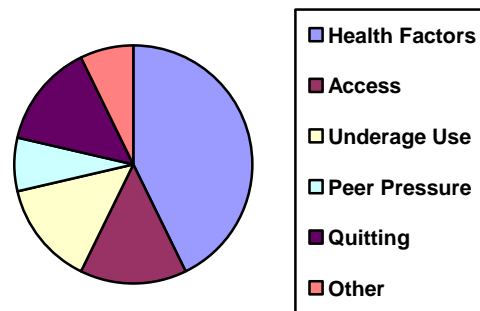

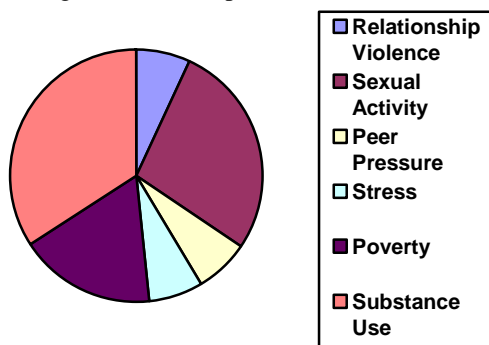

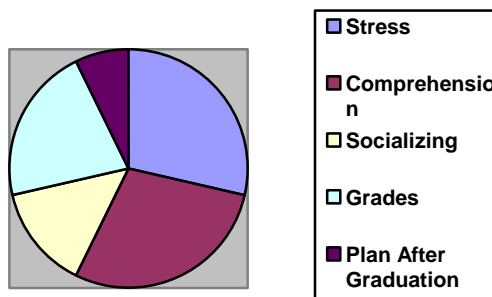

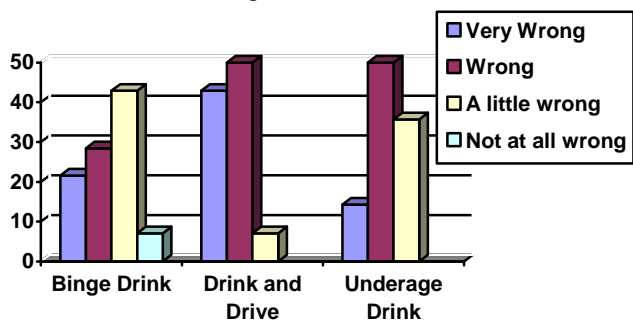

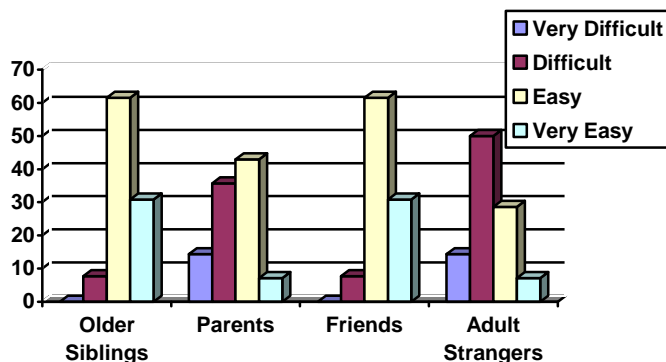

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



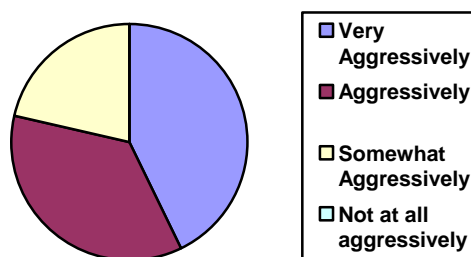

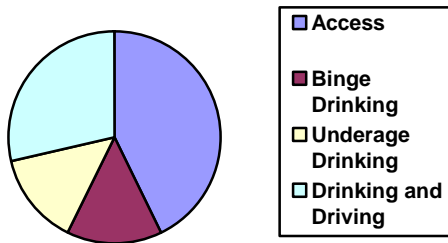

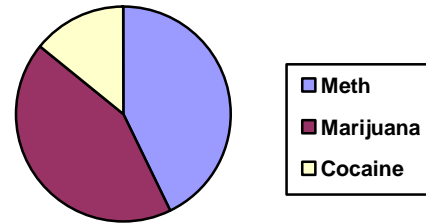

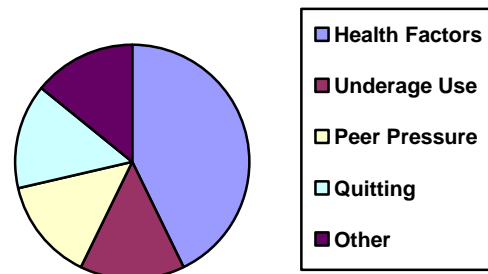

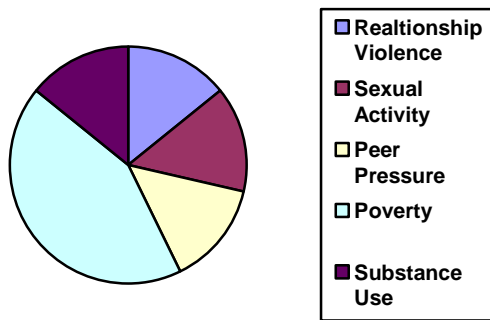

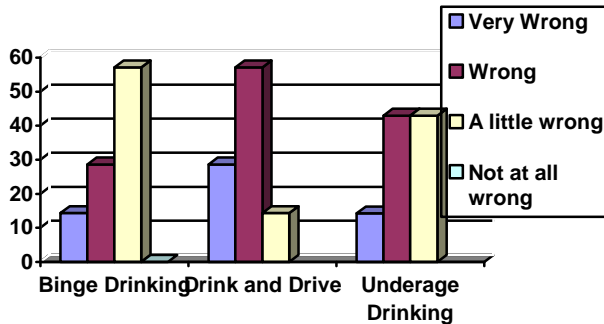

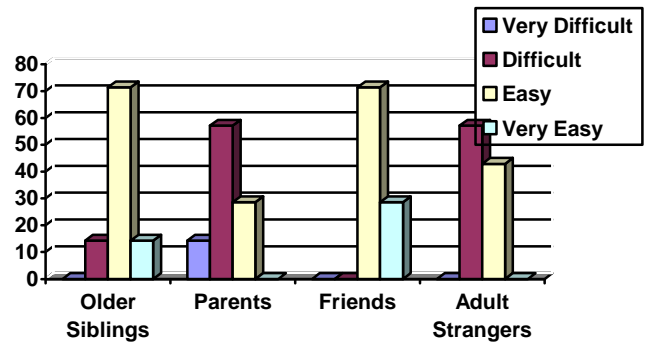

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



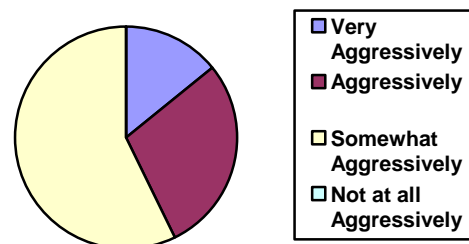

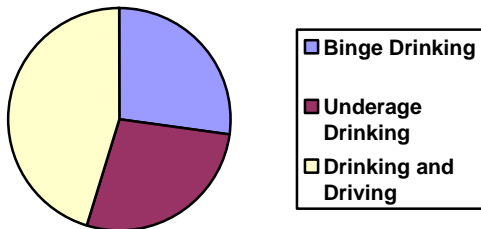

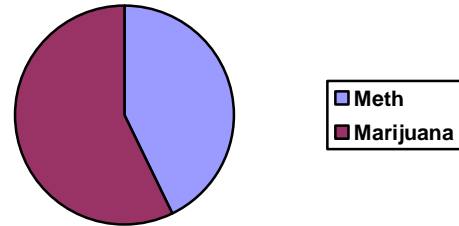

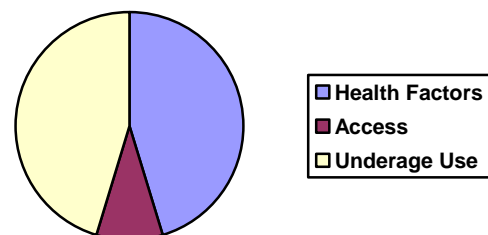

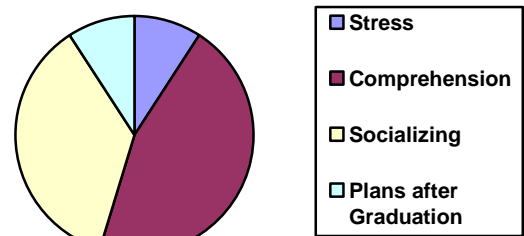

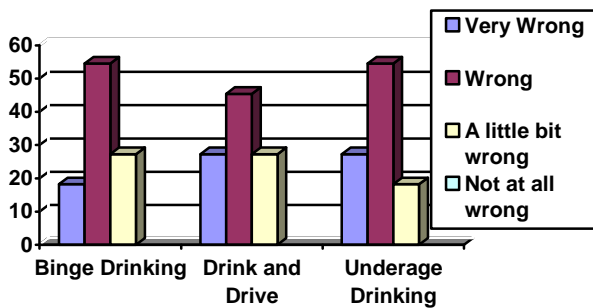

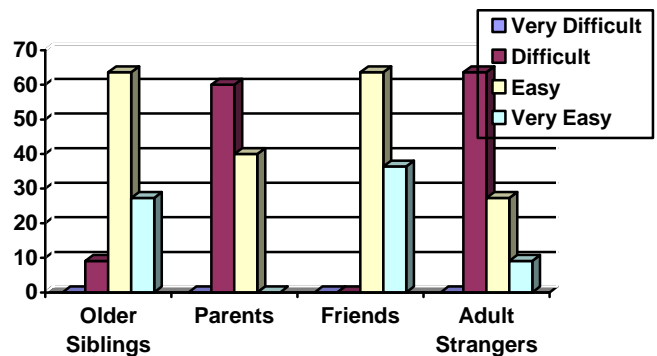

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



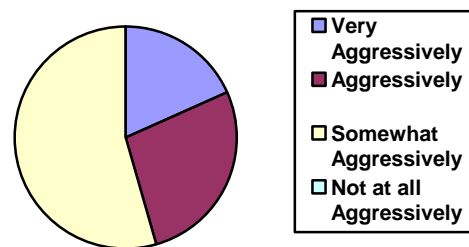

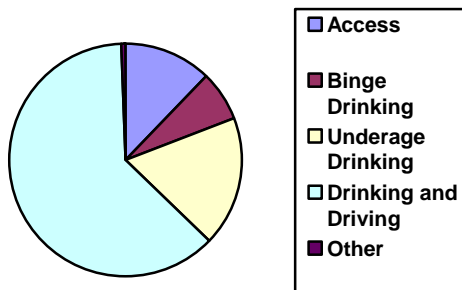

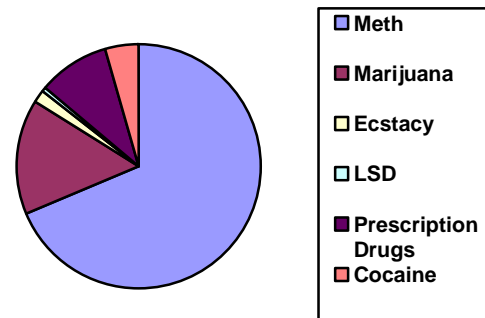

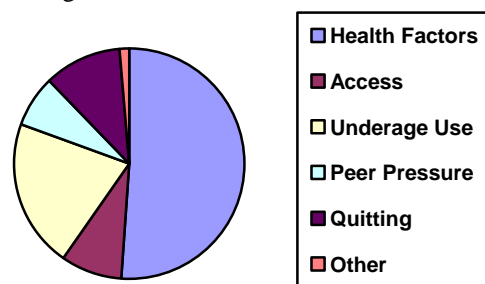

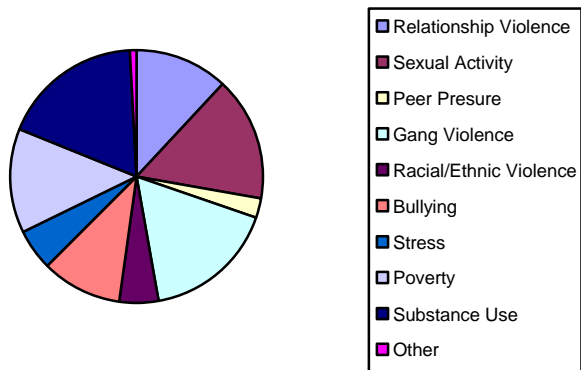

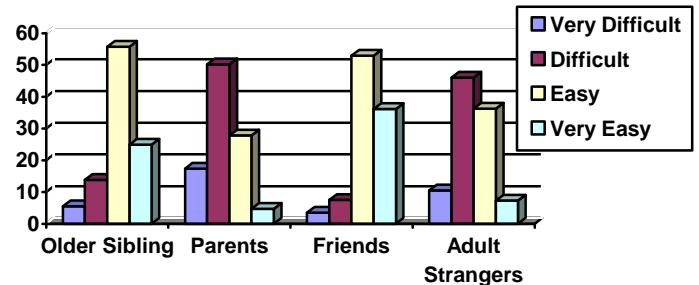
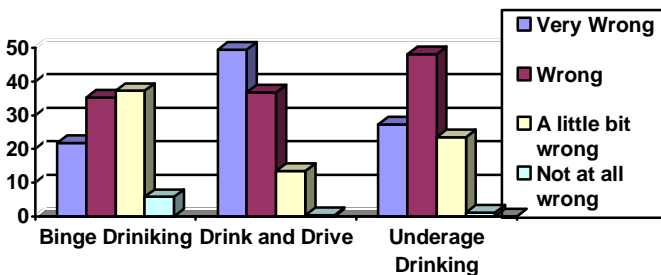


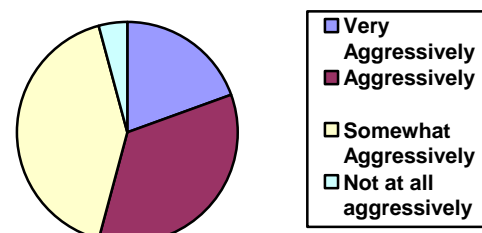

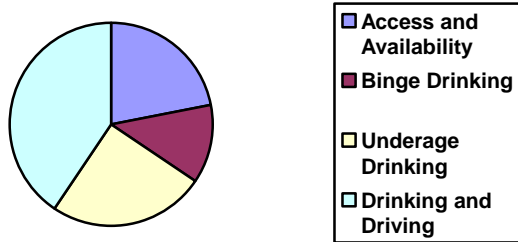

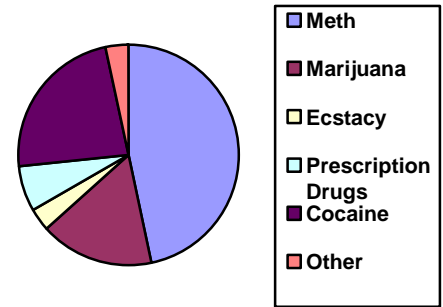

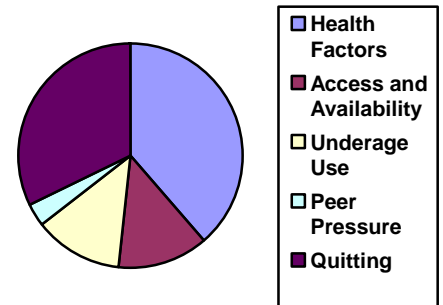

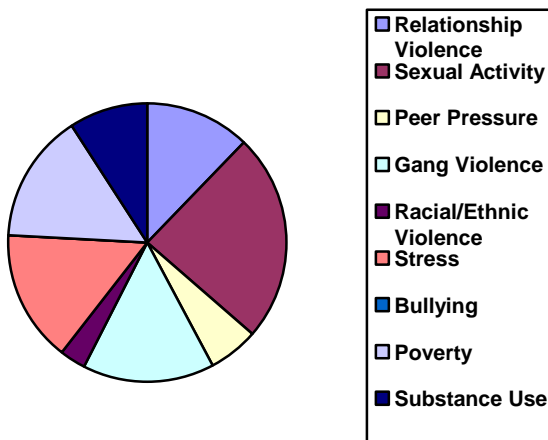

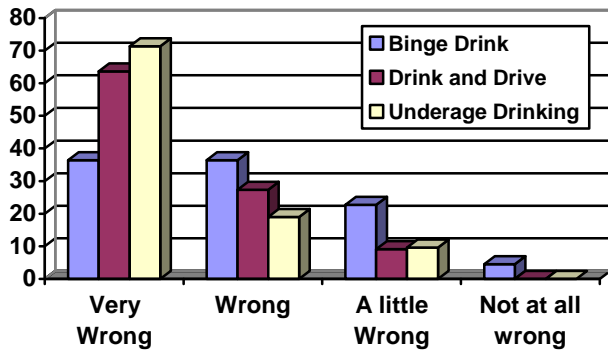

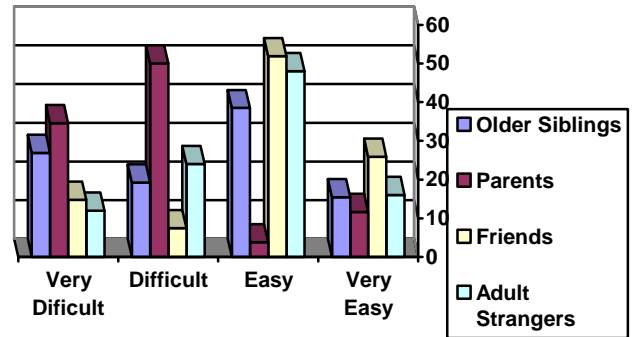

Chart 7: How difficult is it for youth to get alcohol from...



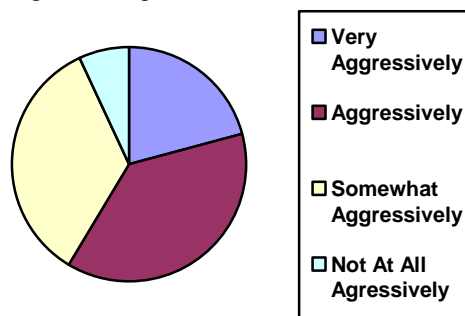

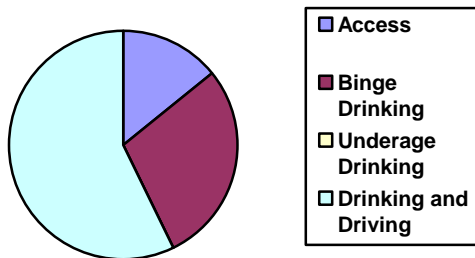

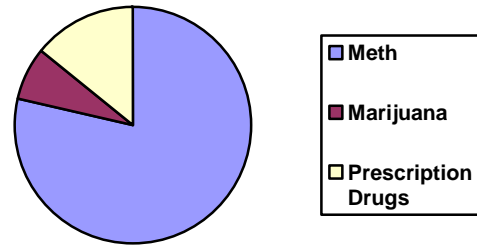

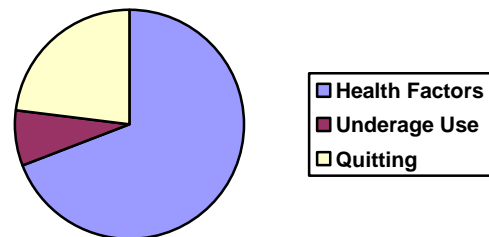

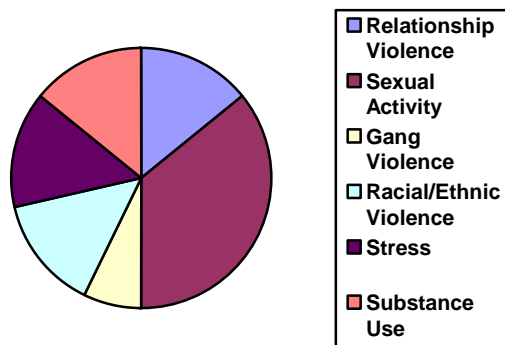

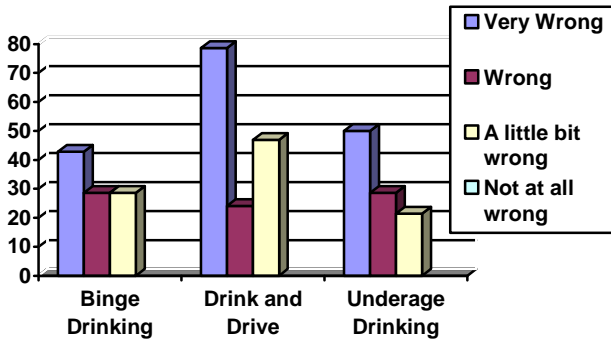

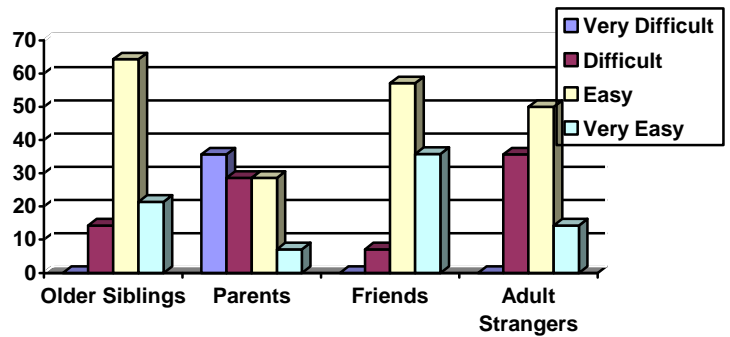

Chart 7: How easy can youth get alcohol from...



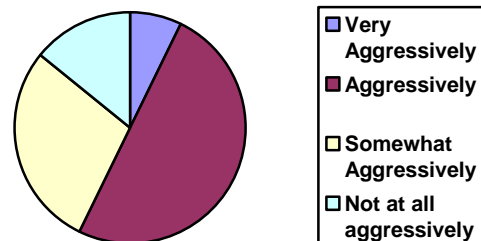

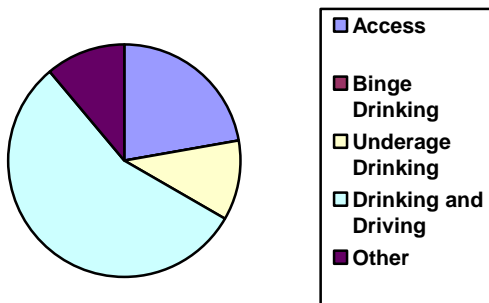

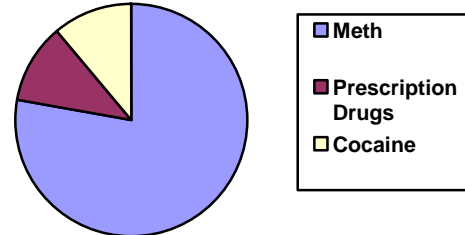

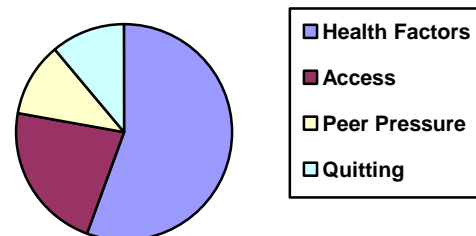

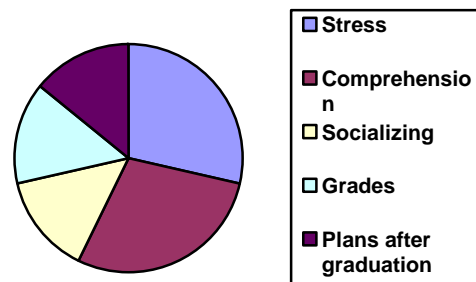

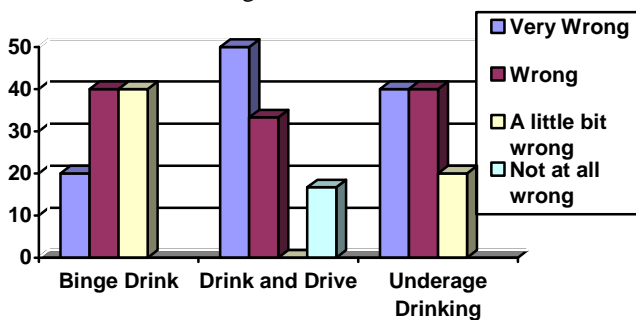

Chart 7: How easy is it for youth to get alcohol from...



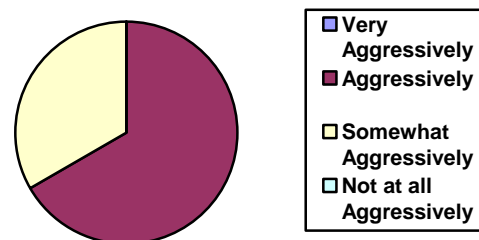
