How the Program Works

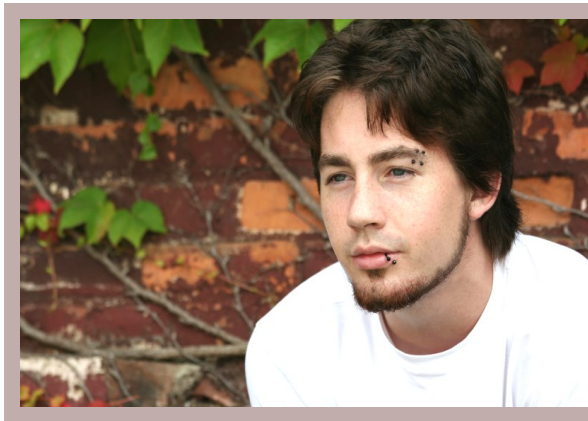
- Transition-Aged Youth Rental Assistance Program is a rental assistance program for low income individuals aged 18-26.
- Program operates much like the federal Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program.
- The assisted individual finds his/her own housing within the Region 6 area of service.
- Rental assistance is based on a declining subsidy.
- The housing program is a transitional or temporary subsidy assisting the participant until they are paying full rent or permanent rental assistance is available.



Eligibility

The participant must...

- be an adult, 18 years of age or older.
- live in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, or Washington Counties, Nebraska.



- be low income in accordance with federal definitions.
- be a U.S. citizen or have legal immigration status.
- participate in the Region 6 Professional Partners program or another case management program for transition aged youth.
- have tried or agree to try at the first opportunity to obtain Section 8 rental assistance.
