Clarification and Enhancement Request**

Written responses from Region 6 Behavioral Healthcare (Region 6) will be provided within two (2) business days to all organizations that submitted a Notification of Intent to Respond.

Organization's Question/Recommendation:

1. Would the fire department be providing a list of individuals to be able to share into the warehouse? Do you have a use case you can please describe into how this data is used?
2. Can you please provide examples of use cases into how you envision to use the data captured in the warehouse?
3. What capabilities do these organizations have to connecting with the data warehouse? APIs, web services etc.
4. Can you please share that information would be pulled from the IMS? How would this information be used?
5. What is the expectation from Region 6 that the Motorola Records and the examples listed are able to be accessed with the data warehouse solution? Do you have a use case examples you can please share on how these would be used?

Region 6's Answer/Response:

1. Data would be provided by all Partners as identified in the RFP. A use case scenario is provided in the response to question 2 (below).
2. How Region 6 and Partners envision using the data captured in the warehouse solution:
An individual's data will be uploaded into the data warehouse solution from the Partners' individual systems based on trigger mechanisms identified during the requirements gathering process.
Use Case Scenario:
911 receives a call that an older male has fallen in the community and is unable to get up. His communication with law enforcement centers around how hopeless the future is and his wishes to be dead. There are no reported thoughts about wishing to harm others. His mood indicates depression, and he smells of alcohol.
 - End Users (Law Enforcement, Co-Responders, and Fire Department First Responders, and Jail personnel) can access an individual's data contained within the data warehouse solution, including last known medications, providers, emergency contacts, etc. This data will be used to inform responses to individuals with mental illness, such as interventions, connections to care, and connections to past providers.
3. Region 6 and Partners' capability to connect with the data warehouse solution will be determined in the requirements gathering process.
4. Region 6 and Partners have identified general data points that should be included within the solution. Specific information to be pulled from IMS and all other Partners' databases will be identified in the requirements gathering process.
5. The intent of the data warehouse solution is to access data from the Motorola Records and other platforms listed within the RFP. Specific data points from each of the Partners' databases will be identified in the requirements gathering process.
